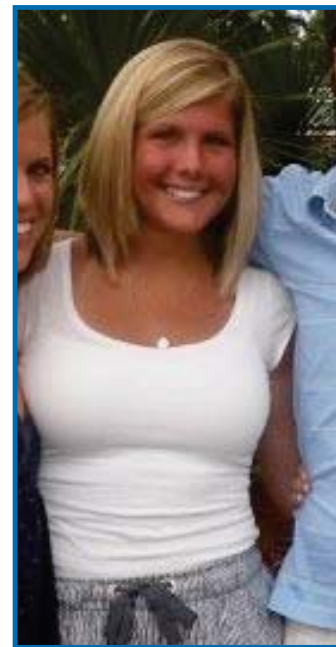

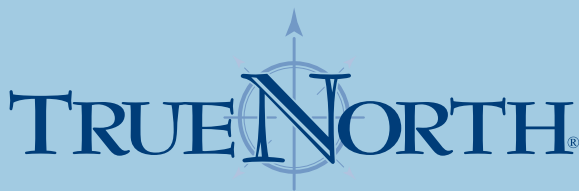

For the 2009-2010 academic year, the Board of Trustees granted \$2,000 academic scholarships to 10 talented young men and women.
